





Five-Year Limited Warranty for Steel Disc Wheels — Wide-Base Wheels — Demountable Rims, including Finish

For Truck, Trailer and Bus Applications

This limited warranty applies to steel single and wide-base tubeless disc wheels, tubeless demountable rims, and tube-type demountable disc wheels and rims and related components manufactured by Maxion Wheels for use in on-highway, medium- and heavy-duty original equipment applications.

WHEELS / RIMS: [Effective 07/01/16]: For a period of five (5) years from the date of manufacture as stamped on the wheel or rim, Maxion Wheels warrants to the original purchaser (or to an end-user who purchases directly from an original purchaser) that it will repair or replace any single or wide-base tubeless disc wheel, tubeless demountable rim, or tube-type demountable disc wheel or rim product which has become unserviceable in normal use due to functional defects in workmanship or materials. This warranty extends to the finish on certain wheels, as more fully described below.

COMPONENTS: For a period of one (1) year from the date of manufacture as stamped on the component, Maxion Wheels warrants to the original purchaser (or to an end-user who purchases directly from an original purchaser) that it will replace any lock ring, flange or side ring which has become unserviceable in normal use due to functional defects in workmanship or materials.

FINISH: For a period of five (5) years from the date of manufacture as stamped on the wheel or rim, Maxion Wheels warrants to the original purchaser (or to an end-user who purchases directly from an original purchaser) that it will repair or replace any hub-piloted single or wide-base tubeless disc wheel finished with original MaxCoat Extra™ powder-coat that has become damaged in normal use due to excessive corrosion caused by defects in workmanship or materials. In lieu of replacement, Maxion Wheels reserves the right to contribute \$35 towards the refinishing cost of any covered wheel. Excessive corrosion is defined as the level of corrosion described and displayed in Maxion Wheels's Technical Bulletin TB 1601. The applicability of this limited finish warranty is expressly conditioned upon use of MaxShield™ or OEM approved wheel protectors (or their equivalents) between the hub/drum and wheel, and between wheels in a dual assembly configuration. Failure to use wheel protectors voids the warranty that applies to the disc mounted surfaces of the wheel.





Five-Year Limited Warranty for Steel Disc Wheels — Wide-Base Wheels — Demountable Rims, including Finish (cont.)

QUALIFICATIONS: Maxion Wheels does not warrant and will not repair or replace any steel wheel or component part that has been subjected to misuse, neglect, or abuse, including any of the following:

- a) Used with an improper tire size;
- b) Subjected to loading in excess of load ratings established by Maxion Wheels;
- c) Used with tires inflated beyond maximum inflation pressures established by Maxion Wheels;
- d) Damaged by improper servicing, maintenance, installation or operation in violation of industry, OEM or Maxion Wheels published product literature applicable for the year of manufacture;
- e) Damaged due to improper mounting or dismounting in violation of applicable OSHA or Maxion Wheels published product literature;
- f) Altered or modified from its original condition in any manner, including refinishing;
- g) Damaged by accidents, abnormal or severe operating conditions, fires, excessive speeds, or impact with road hazards (such as curbing or potholes);
- h) Damaged by failure to follow maintenance, instructions and warnings set forth in Maxion Wheels published product literature;
- i) Damaged by use with a spacer of any kind; or
- j) Damaged by other non-wheel components

In addition, Maxion Wheels does not warrant the finish against and will not repair or replace any of the following:

- a) Damage to the finish during servicing due to the use of improper tools or procedures, or balancing with wheel weights;
- b) Damage to the finish by cleaning with abrasives, abrasive brushes, steel wool, scouring pads or strong chemicals:
- c) Damage to the finish caused by contact with the hub pilot pads or other non-Maxion Wheels components (such as CTIS/TPMS systems or wheel covers);
- d) Nicks, scratches, chipping or other surface blemishes caused by contact with road obstacles or debris;
- e) Corrosion in the crevice between the rim and disc components;
- f) Damage or corrosion in the area under the mounting fasteners. Failure to use wheel protectors voids the warranty that applies to the disc mounted surfaces of the wheel;
- g) Damage to the finish due to extreme or severe operating conditions; or
- h) Damage to the finish due to improper handling or storage

Unless otherwise specified above, Maxion Wheels's obligation under this warranty is limited to repair or replacement of any product shown to be defective within the applicable provisions of this warranty (upon inspection, if necessary, of failed parts, associated vehicles or maintenance records). Replacement parts will be shipped FOB Maxion Wheels.

Upon request, products subject to a warranty claim shall be returned to the place of manufacture or to an authorized Maxion Wheels representative, with shipping charges pre-paid.

THIS LIMITED WARRANTY IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER WARRANTIES, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE, APPLICATION OR USE. UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES SHALL MAXION WHEELS LIABILITY EXCEED THE ORIGINAL PRICE OF THE PRODUCT, NOR SHALL MAXION WHEELS BE LIABLE FOR ANY SPECIAL, INCIDENTAL, PUNITIVE OR CONSEQUENTIAL DAMAGES.
